#### Notes:

- The four experiential learning (clinical) courses end in the number 6, with the exception of N327, which is part of the two-course N326/N327 sequence. Students complete seven clinical rotations during the program.
- Students in the Nursing Honors Program complete N679 Nursing Honors Research Seminar (2cr) during the Year One spring term. They also enroll in the 2-credit N442 Health Systems, Policy, and Economics (instead of N444) during the Year Two spring term, and complete the N681/N682 Senior Honors Thesis (2–4cr) sequence in the fall and spring of Year Two.
- Nursing electives are offered each semester. Options may include N470 School Nursing, N510 Culturally Congruent Practice, N590 Leadership for Innovation in Healthcare, and more.
